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Online Data Entry System

Licensing

The annual \$200-per-user fee gives you access to the MOB online data entry system.

Choose a user account type:

Organizations typically have one user. However, two or more organizations that provide A Matter of Balance (MOB) within the same state or region may choose to form a data sharing group. These organizations can share a single data entry user, send their class forms to one location for entry, and can get reports on MOB activity within their state or region, at the cost of a single license fee.

If you collected MOB data under the prior scannable form system (before March 2011) and you choose to use the MOB online data entry system, your historical data will be available to you in the online system.
