HEALTH PROFESSIONS EDUCATION

Post-graduate fellowships, residencies and on-site clinical training for students in the TUSM — Maine Track program and other medical schools



RESEARCH

Investment in biomedical research activities through the Maine Medical Center Research Institute



PROVIDER EMPLOYMENT

\$60,558,000

Mission-critical specialty care, such as high risk obstetrics, that requires subsidies to make available to the community



COMMUNITY BUILDING ACTIVITIES

Disaster and emergency preparedness planning and training, workforce development opportunities such as the Certified Nursing Assistant Training Program and Healthcare Professional Pipeline Program



SUBSIDIZED HEALTH SERVICES

Funding for and access to free programs such as Care Partners, MedAccess, language interpreters and patient navigators
