I have other commitments. Can I attend just part of the PME program?

PME is designed as a comprehensive educational program. In order to fully benefit from the experience, participation of the entire full-day program is highly recommended.

Are there confidentiality requirements?

Yes, you will be asked to review and sign a MMC Confidentiality Agreement. Confidentiality of patient-specific information is critically important. You will be granted temporary observation privileges by MMC as indicated by your guest ID.

Will patients be OK with me entering their room?

In general, yes. Our patients at MMC are informed that it is a teaching hospital and are aware that they will interact with patient care teams. You will be a part of a patient care team. You will be required to sign a confidentiality agreement and keep all patient-specific information completely confidential.

Is it a problem if I'm squeamish at the sight of blood or needles?

Not at all. If you're sensitive to particular situations, please let us know in advance. We'll take that into account when arranging your clinical time with the resident.

What else do I need to know before arriving?

Attire is business casual. Please wear comfortable clothes and shoes for the clinical rotation. We ask that your cell phones remain off while in the hospital. We'll try to provide time for you to check messages as needed.
